Travelers depart from Catania on the **Etna and Taormina Tour** to witness the natural beauty and picturesque sights of the Silvestri craters from the volcanic eruption of 1892; the Zafferana Etnea, a famous organic farm that produces honey, wine and other staples; the Isola Bella wildlife reserve, which is considered the “pearl of the Ionian sea” and historical palaces and cathedrals of Taormina.
- In southern Thailand where professional instructors of the **Phuket Cooking Class** lead the preparation of mouthwatering Thai dishes with a market tour and an interactive, hands-on cooking experience. The **Phuket Island Tour** provides a guided cultural and architectural heritage tour of the island with sights of temples, offshore islands and Sino-Portuguese buildings.
- In Hong Kong where travelers can take the **Hong Kong Munchies Walking Tour**. This gastronomic adventure along the Dr Sun Yat-sen Historical Trail, a haven for foodies, is filled with samples of local favorites such as egg tart, dim sum, wonton noodles, Hong Kong French toast and renowned silk stocking milk tea.
